I love to go camping, hiking, kayaking, and rock hunting. I also love to spend time in my garden and read.

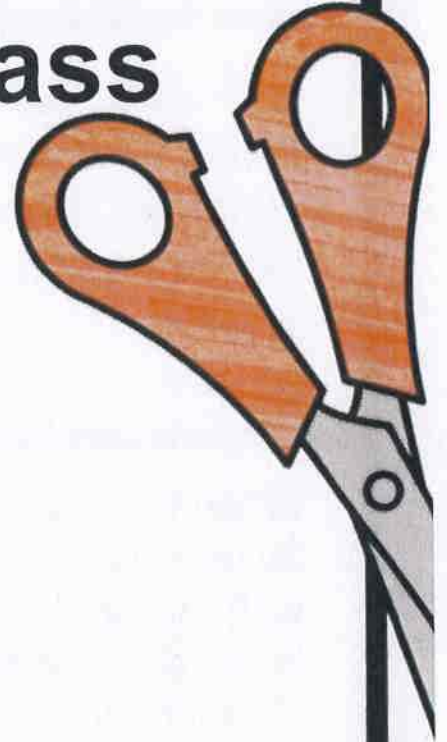

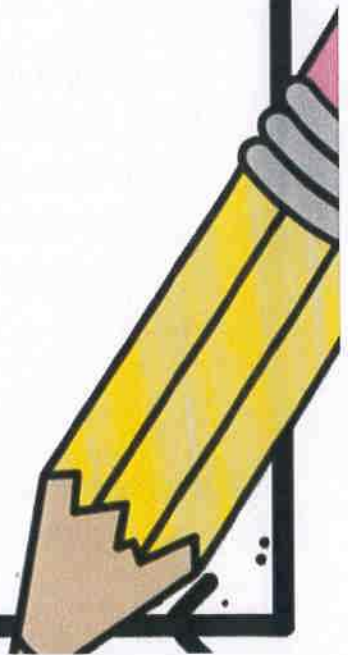
# SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

# SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

- 1 box of CRAYOLA crayons (24 count at least)
- 1 box of CRAYOLA colored pencils
- 1 package of CRAYOLA WASHABLE markers
- Small pencil box (6x9) to hold supplies
- 1 PLASTIC folder
- Pencils (at least 2 dozen)
- 2 large pink erasers
- 15-20 glue sticks (we go through LOTS of glue sticks in 1st grade.)
- 1 pair of FISKARS scissors (the "slightly pointed" ones seem to work the best for the students)
- 1-inch hard cover 3-ring binder
- A GOOD set of headphones. (NO ear buds)
- Backpack
- 3 containers of Lysol/Clorox wipes
- 2-3 boxes of Kleenex
- Paint smock (an old t-shirt works fine )
- Gym shoes (to be KEPT at school)
- 1 Box of GALLON SLIDER Ziploc bags. (everyone)
- 1 box SNACK size (boys)
- 1 box QUART size plastic bags (girls)
- 1 LARGE hand sanitizer
- 1 box of ANY of the following:  
goldfish, cheese-it, crackers, cookies, cereal, pretzels, popcorn, fruit snacks, etc. (For the snack cupboard in case someone "forgets" their day.)
