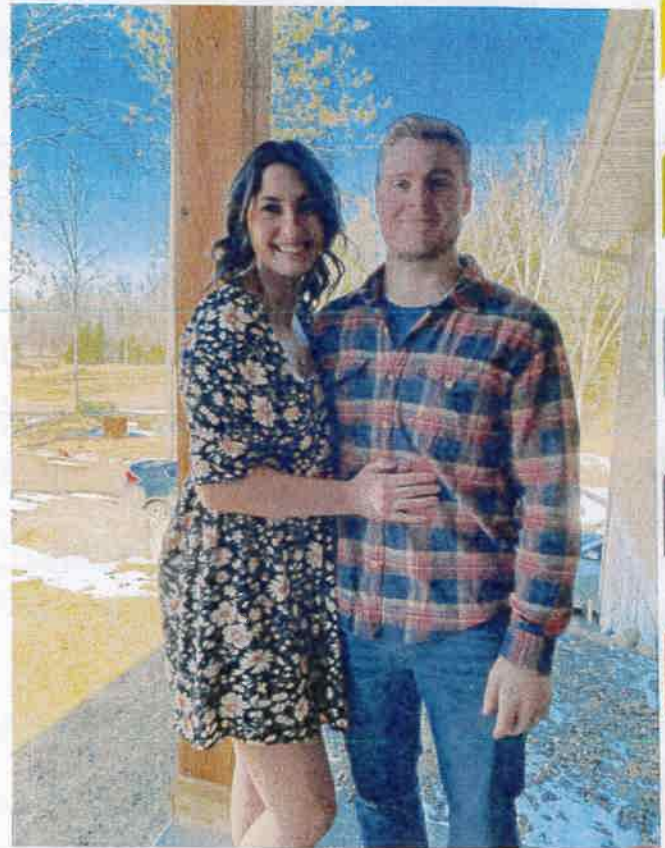
Welcome to Fourth Grade!
