With the current situation, each student will need to bring their own supplies which will NOT be shared with other students in our class. I ask that you please label EVERY item with your child's name (including labeling individual pencils). I ask that you please contribute the following supplies for your child to use in our classroom.

- ★ 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

- ★ 1 pair of scissors
- ★ 2 highlighters (different colors)
- ★ 1 large eraser
- ★ 24 pencils
- ★ 1 pack of colored pencils
- ★ Headphones or earbuds
- ★ Art smock
- ★ Phy. Ed. shoes
- ★ 3 two-pocket folders
- ★ 5 single-subject, wide-ruled notebooks
- ★ 1 package of wide-ruled loose leaf paper
