

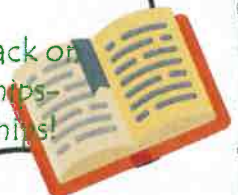

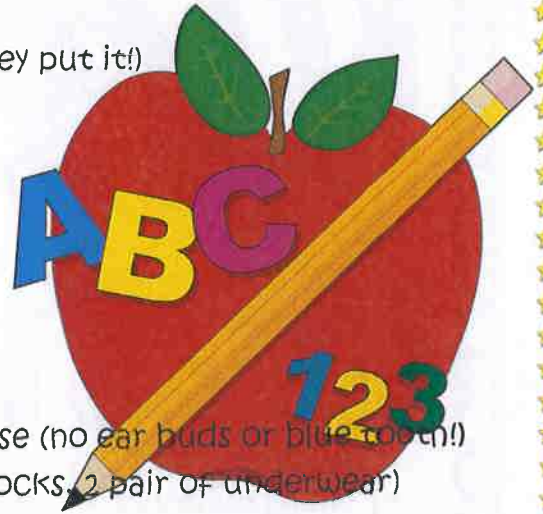
I love pasta. I like to snack on crackers and potato chips- especially dill pickle chips!
