Dear Parents,

We will be doing many exciting things in second grade. To help your child be ready for second grade, encourage him/her to continue reading and writing over the summer. Since we will be working on telling time and counting money, it would be helpful to practice these concepts. Playing number games or card games is also a good way to practice math facts.

Here is a list of supplies needed for the second grade:

2 boxes of sharpened pencils*	pencil sharpener
Small pencil box	2 large erasers
Scissors	crayons and colored pencils
Markers (optional)	8 glue sticks*
4 spiral notebooks	5 black dry-erase markers
3 folders	2 containers of cleaning wipes*
A pair of headphones	book bag
Gym shoes to be kept at the school	1 box of Ziploc bags (any size)
2 boxes of Kleenex (to be shared)*	Paint smock
1 or 1.5 inch (3-ring) binder	

*Supplies might need replenished sometime in the year.

For snack, we ask students to bring their own snack for our daily **snack time**. A large box of cereal, crackers, or bars can be kept here at school. We go through a large number of plastic utensils and paper plates. **Please include one of these items to bring in with your child's supplies: plastic forks, plastic spoons, or paper plates.**

Please label all supplies with your child's name and check throughout the year to see if a replacement is needed. We will keep the Kleenex and wipes in a cabinet to be used throughout the year.

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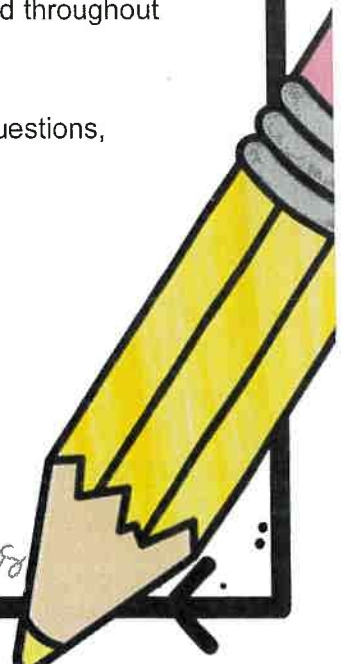
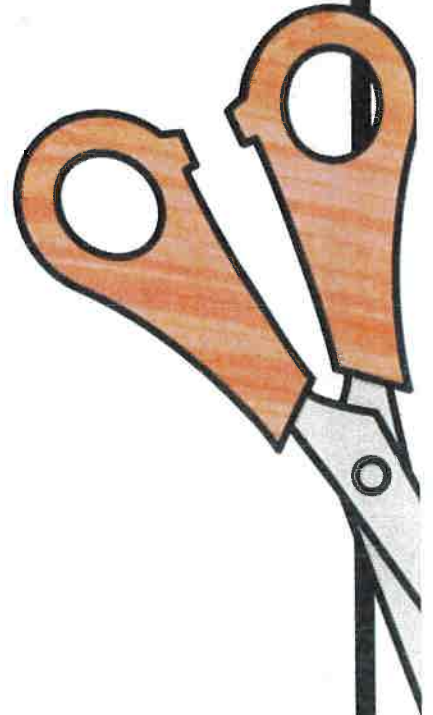
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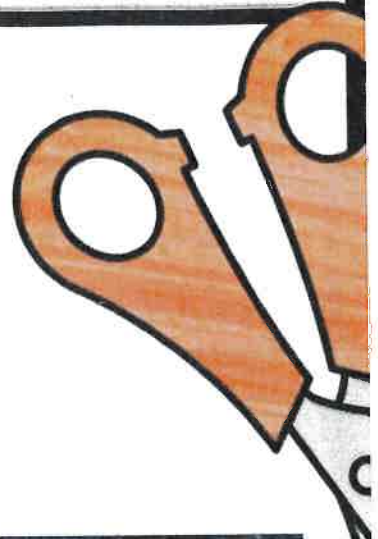
Meet Your Teachers!
