- 5) Approval of personnel report
 - a. Hiring of Garith Pipkorn at K-12 art teacher and Jennie Kleinhans and Tina Gilge as remedial summer school teachers.
 - b. Accepted resignations from Amy Pippenger as 6-12 math teacher, boys tennis and girls tennis coach; and Caleb Lallemont as head custodian at the pool (effective August 1).

The following items were approved after the closed session of the Board of Education at the June 16, 2014 meeting:

1) Approve 1.5% increase in wages for all non-affiliated employees for 2014-15, with the exception of Dave Scholz who will receive a \$5,000 increase in salary that was negotiated in his hiring last spring and Rick Morgan who will have a salary freeze for 2014-15.
