

Board Meeting Update

July 21, 2025

The following items were approved during the open session of the July 21, 2025 Regular Board of Education Meeting:

- A. Approved the Design/Engineering and Bidding/State Review portions of the HSR proposal for the greenhouse project for \$27,014 plus State Review allowance of \$1500-\$2500.
- B. Approved quote from Blakeman Plumbing for men's front entry bathroom plumbing work for \$16,250.79.
- C. Approved state/federal mandated price increase of \$.10 on all student meals and \$.44 for adult breakfast and \$.45 for adult lunch.
- D. Approved participation in WIAA for the 2025-2026 school year.
- E. Approved eLuma contract for 2025-2026 online speech and occupational therapists and school psychologist for \$266,295.00.
