- 1. The School Board shall hold a regular meeting at least once each month and at other times upon the written request of any School Board member. The request shall be filed with the School District clerk or, in his/her absence, the School District president, who shall notify in writing each School Board member of the time and the place of the special School Board meeting at least 24 hours before such meeting. Public notice of all meetings shall be given according to State law.
- 2. The Board meets in the Phillips Middle School at six o'clock in the evening on the third Monday of each month, unless public notice is given relative to a change of date and/or time and location.
- The public is invited to attend all Board meetings except when the Board is meeting in <u>Executive/Closed Session</u> for any purpose permitted by State law. (19.85)
