ANNUAL BOARD REORGANIZATION MEETING

174

The Board of Education shall hold an annual reorganization meeting on or within thirty (30) days after the fourth Monday in April. The meeting shall be called to order by the ranking officer of the preceding Board, who shall serve as presiding officer until the election of the Board President.

Election of officers shall be by a majority of the full Board. Where no such majority exists on the first ballot vote, a second vote shall be cast for the two (2) candidates who received the greatest number of ballot votes.

Except for those appointed to fill a vacancy, officers shall serve for one (1) year until their respective successors are elected and shall qualify. An officer may be removed for cause by a majority vote of the full Board.
