OPERATING PROCEDURES

Unless otherwise stated within the manual of policies, *"Robert's Rules of Order"* shall govern the deliberations of the Board of Education.

- 1. Except in emergencies, the Board should not attempt to decide upon any question before examining and evaluating any reasonable information any person requests the Board to consider.
- 2. To suspend a rule or to change the order of business, a two-thirds vote of the members present shall be required.
