Voting at Board meetings will normally be by voice vote, unless a roll call vote is required by law or requested. A Roll call vote may be requested by any member of the Board.

A majority of all votes cast at a duly constituted meeting is necessary for the transaction of Board business. The Board President shall have a vote just as other Board members. Unless the statutes specifically provide otherwise, secret ballots are to be taken only to elect Board officers.

Board members may be considered present and a participating member during meetings through electronic communication. Members may vote on a topic of interest if they have participated in the meeting and discussion for that topic.
