342.5 Rule

Parental Involvement

1. In the School District of Phillips it is understood that parents are important in the education of their children. Therefore, building meetings will be conducted in which the parents of eligible Title I students will be invited to participate.
2. In addition to the above requirement, the following activities are a part of a total Title I program.
 - a. Notify each child's parents that the child has been selected to participate in Title I and why the child has been selected.
 - b. Inform parents of Title I curriculum.
 - c. Inform the parents of their child's progress at conferences.
 - d. Provide materials for students to continue the learning at home with their parents.
 - e. Conduct parent meetings to discuss educational issues and instructional techniques.
 - f. Inform the parents of an open door policy during class instruction.
 - g. Request parents' suggestions in planning, development, and operation of the program.
 - h. Discuss with parents how the school can work with parents to achieve the program's objectives.
