The Board is legally responsible for all matters relating to the operation of the School District of Phillips. The responsibility for the selection of instructional materials, however, is delegated to the professionally trained certified personnel of the District.

Selections of materials may involve instructional media specialists, principals, teachers, students, administrators, and community persons. The selection and purchase of instructional materials shall be the responsibility of the certified library/media personnel.

Specific selection procedures shall be developed for use in the District.

The School District of Phillips shall not discriminate in the selection and evaluation of instructional and library materials on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability, or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
