## EQUAL ACCESS TO SCHOOL FACILITIES

Students in the School District of Phillips shall have the opportunity to receive their education in facilities that are safe, healthful, and accessible. Programs and activities provided in each building shall be under the direction of the building principal and/or District superintendent.

Rules and regulations governing the use of District facilities shall be established by the School Board.

The School District shall not discriminate in facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap.
