

Middle School

The interscholastic athletic program is an integral part of the educational process that promotes sportsmanship, citizenship, and competition, and is open to all interested and eligible students. A policy of wide participation is endorsed with the expectation that, normally, all athletes will receive playing time in athletic contests.

High School

The interscholastic athletic program is an integral part of the educational process that promotes sportsmanship, citizenship, and competition, and is open to all interested and eligible students. Emphasis on competition will increase as players move from the freshman level to the varsity level. A policy of wide participation is endorsed. There may be a selection process (try-outs) for the students involved in athletics which will be determined by the respective head coach. Before cuts can be made in a sport, they must be approved by the building principal and athletic director.

On the high school level, the head coach determines the philosophy and patterns for other coaches to follow in terms of such things as techniques, player development, playing time, etc.
