

SELF-FUNDED CO-CURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Policy 377.4

The School Board will allow individuals and groups the option to self-fund pre-existing, co-curricular programs that through Board action are no longer funded by the School District. The purpose of providing this option is to preserve the opportunity for students to continue participating in pre-existing programs.

It is the policy of the School District of Phillips, pursuant to s. 118.13, Wis. Stats., and PI 9, that no person, on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability, may be denied admission to any school in this district or be denied participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be discriminated against in any curricular, extracurricular, pupil services, recreational, or other program.
