Extracurricular activities programs shall be offered to students in the schools in the District. Participation in extracurricular activities shall be in accordance with established school and activity rules.

The Administration shall provide advisors for supervision of all extracurricular activities.

Students who violate school and/or activity rules shall be subject to disciplinary action.

The School District of Phillips shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions, or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexuial orientation, physical, mental, emotion or learning disability, or handicap.
