- I. Full-time Student -- A full-time student is a student whose daily schedule requires attendance in class and supervised activities from the beginning of the school day until the end of the school day as determined by the Board of Education.
- II. Special Cases Students with special needs may be enrolled for fewer classes or hours and still be considered full-time. Examples of special needs students would include, but not be limited to, the following: special education students, truants, homebound students, school age mothers, students at risk, and students in work-experience programs. In all incidences where modification to the regular school program is considered necessary, it must be approved by the building principal and notice must be provided to the superintendent.
