ADMISSION OF STUDENTS LIVING WITH OTHER PARTIES

In the event that a minor student whose parent/guardian resides outside the boundaries of the School District of Phillips is sent by the parent/guardian to live with other relatives within the District, the following policy shall govern the enrollment of that student in District schools.

- 1. An affidavit signed by the parent/guardian shall be required. This affidavit shall include:
 - a. the citing of the specific reason why the student is being placed in our district.
 - b. a legal authorization, such as power of attorney, that the relative or other parties with whom the child will be living will be responsible for all aspects of the child's school behavior and attendance.
 - c. a legal authorization, such as power of attorney, that names a local doctor and grants consent to treatment and payment for treatment for the child from this doctor should a medical situation rise.
- 2. Based on the affidavit, the administration shall determine whether or not the child will be permitted to enroll in the school of the District.
- 3. This policy does not apply to non-resident students under the District's Open Enrollment Policy.
