

ADULT EDUCATION

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Any adult education program shall be sponsored by the Board of Education along the same principles as used in the education of youth. The program shall not interfere with the objective of the school, that of educating children.

The program shall aim to improve democratic citizenship, provide for economic improvement and cultural development, and enrich personal and family living.

The program shall be administered by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her representative.

The curriculum shall be designed to meet the needs and wishes of the citizens of the District. No class shall be operated for an enrollment of less than ten persons. The program shall be financially self-sustaining.
