Absentee Voting Information

Please note that this is the most recent information available when written as of Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup>. This is subject to change.

At Phillips School District, we acknowledge that the COVID-19 crisis is affecting our lives in unprecedented ways. We are also mindful that many individuals in our school community are experiencing disruption in everyday routines, employment and health.

Be assured that our first priority is the safety and well-being of our students, staff and the larger community. We continue to encourage social distancing and avoiding crowds as public health officials have advised.

With everyone's safety in mind, we felt it important to relay information about the upcoming April 7 elections. As we continue to navigate the unknown, we have been advised that the April 7 Spring Election and Presidential Preference Primary is **continuing as scheduled**. We advise our residents to follow the Wisconsin Elections Commission recommendation, and plan to vote absentee.

#### How to vote absentee:

- You must be registered voter to request an absentee ballot
- If you are not a registered voter, residents can register to vote with an photo id:
  - Online at <https://myvote.wi.gov> – now extended until Monday, March 30
  - in-person, at your municipal clerk's office until Friday, April 3.
- Voters should request an absentee ballot as soon as they are able. The deadline is Thursday, April 2 - but do not wait!
- Request an absentee ballot online at <https://myvote.wi.gov> or contact your municipality:

Be sure to call ahead before going to the clerk's office, as in-person hours and polling locations may be modified in light of the public health order. Schools, libraries and government facilities are exempt from the health department restriction on public gatherings, so those locations may still be used as polling places.
