PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

Individual parent-teacher conferences for all students will be scheduled during the weeks of November 13-17, and November 27-December 1.

Teachers will share a schedule with parents of available conference times via the SANGHA app and you may sign up via the SANGHA app, by email, or phone call, for a time that works for you.

New this year, all parent-teacher conferences will be scheduled to allow 30 minutes per conference. Individual sessions offer opportunities for your family and teacher to deepen your relationship as partners, discuss your child's progress at home and at school, and collaboratively create a course of action to support your child's growth and improvement.

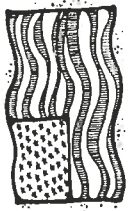
