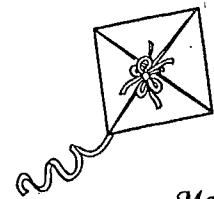

MORNING STUDENT DROP-OFF

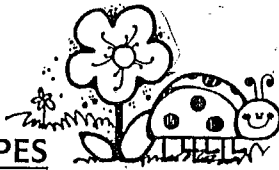

FAMILY FORUM HEAD START

Family Forum Head Start, located in the Phillips Elementary School, is in the process of spring recruitment. Head Start is a nationally recognized pre-school program for low income families. The center in Phillips serves children throughout Price County. Center-based children must be 3 or 4 years of age on or before September 1st, 2018. Four-year-old kindergarten is available and operates 5 half days per week. The home-based option is also available for prenatal to 4 years. Please call 715-339-2040 for more information and to request an application. Applications will be available at many locations throughout Price County.

SCHOOLWIDE TITLE 1 IN PES

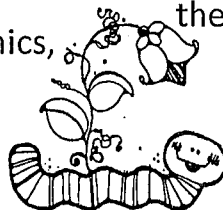
Because PES is considered a low income school, it is called a Schoolwide Title 1 school. This means that all students are considered Title 1 students and can receive help from Title 1 staff anytime they show a need for it. All parents have been asked to complete a 'compact' (agreement) indicating that they are a part of a Schoolwide program.

There will be an early dismissal day for students on Thursday, March 29. PES students will be dismissed at 12:45 on that day. Friday, March 30th and Monday, April 2nd are vacation days for students and there will be no school on those 2 days.



TITLE 1 PARENT INFORMATION

Under the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act, also known as the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB), any public school teacher, elementary or secondary, who teaches a core academic (English, reading or language arts, math, science, history, civics and government, geography, economics,



the arts and foreign language) must be highly qualified (ESEA Title 1, Section 1111(h)(6) and final Regulation Sec. 200.61. Parents' Right to Know). Special education teachers and teachers of English language learners must be highly qualified if they teach core academic subjects to their students (ESEA Title 1, Section 1119).

Parents have the right to request the following information on the professional qualifications of their children's teachers:

- Whether the teacher has met state qualifications and has a license of the grade level and the subject area he or she teaches;
- Whether the teacher has an emergency license;
- What degrees the teacher holds and the field of discipline of his or her certification or degree; and
- Whether the child is being provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.


Any request will be answered within 15 days.

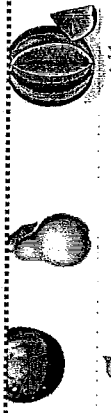
Parents will also be notified if their child has been assigned, or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher of a core academic subject who does not meet the highly qualified requirement.
