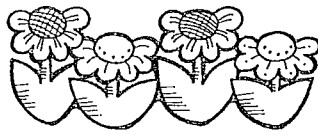

WI FORWARD EXAM FOR 3RD, 4TH, AND 5TH GRADE – APRIL 17 THROUGH APRIL 26TH

Students will be taking the WI Forward exam at PES April 17-19 and April 24-26. This assessment will test students on math, reading/writing (grades 3, 4, and 5) and science and social studies (grade 4 only). This new assessment will be used to gauge how well students are mastering the WI College and Career Readiness Standards.

Students will take the WI Forward exam online. The exam includes multiple choice questions, short answer questions, and a performance task where students must take part in a group classroom activity and then answer a series of short answer questions on the computer for that content.

Grade 3, 4, and 5 students will start testing at 8:30 a.m. and conclude testing around 11:30 most days with some afternoon testing for 4th grade. **Please make every effort to have your child well rested and in school on time for this very important exam.**

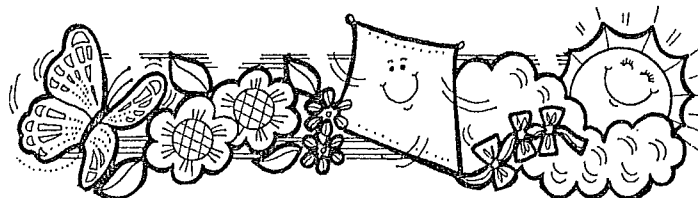

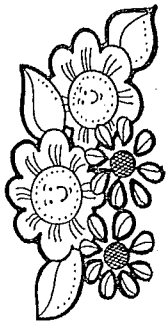
HEAD START

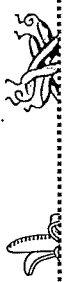
