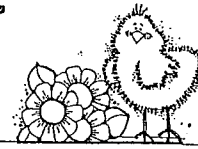

EARLY CHILDHOOD PLAYGROUND

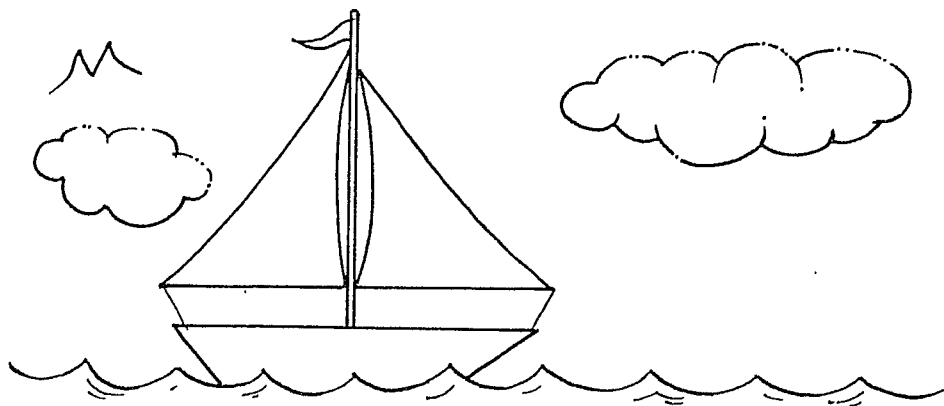
During baseball games on the field behind the elementary school, we are asking parents to report any vandalism or stop anyone from vandalizing the Early Childhood playground.

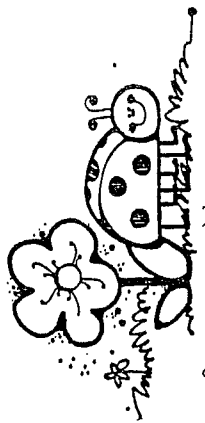

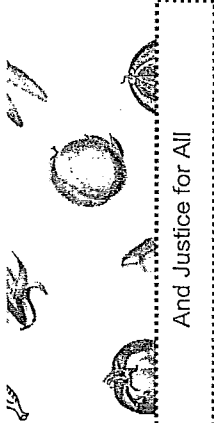
