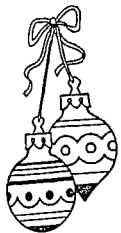

During the 1st quarter of the year many PES students had perfect attendance. Wow! Way to go parents for having your child/children attend school regularly when they are healthy.

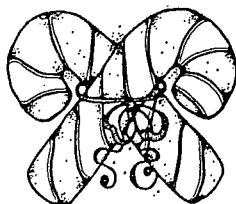

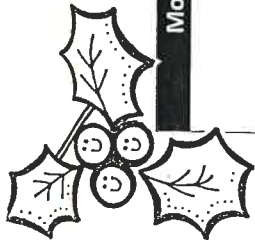

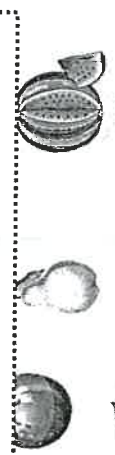
