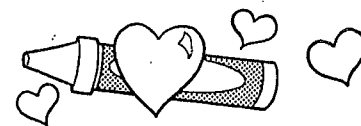

## PLEASE NOTE . . .

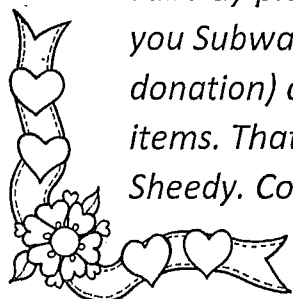
There will be no school for students on Thursday, February 1<sup>st</sup>, and Friday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
