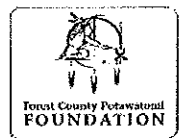

Identification

- Social Security Number
- Driver's License (if you have one)
- Your alien registration or permanent resident card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Date of birth
- Parents' month and year of marriage, divorce or separation

Income Information & Tax Forms

- 2014 W-2, recent pay stub, or 2013 tax return and other records of money earned
You don't have to wait until after you file your taxes! You are allowed to use estimates. OR
- 2014 Federal Income Tax Return (and your spouse's, if you are married)
 - IRS, 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ
 - Foreign Tax Return, or
 - Tax Return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federal States of Micronesia, or Palau
- 2014 untaxed income records
 - Veterans non-education benefit records
 - Child support received

Statements & Records

- Information on savings, investments, business assets and farm assets (if applicable)
